APPLICATION OF TARIFF

This tariff sets forth the service offerings, rates and terms and conditions of service applicable to the furnishing of local exchange telecommunications services by NOS Communications, Inc. ("NOS" or "Company") to Customers within the State of Ohio.

1.1 <u>Definitions</u>

<u>Authorized User</u> – A person, firm or corporation which is authorized by the Customer or joint user to be connected to the Service of the Customer or joint user, respectively.

<u>Automatic Numbering Identification</u> – A type of signaling provided by a local exchange telephone company, which automatically identifies the local exchange line from which a call originates.

<u>Business Day</u> – The period of time from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, as measured by local time at the location from which the Call is originated.

<u>Busy Hour</u> – The two consecutive half hours during which the greatest volume of traffic is handled in the central office.

<u>Call</u> – A completed connection between the Calling and Called parties.

<u>Calling Station</u> – The telephone number from which a Call originates.

<u>Called Station</u> – The telephone number called.

<u>Carrier</u> – An entity, other than the Company, that provides telecommunications service.

<u>Commission</u> – Ohio Public Utilities Commission .

<u>Company</u> – NOS Communications, Inc., unless specifically stated otherwise.

<u>Customer</u> – A person, association, firm, corporation, partnership, governmental agency or other entity, including affiliates or divisions of the Customer, in whose name the telephone number of the Calling Station is registered with the underlying local exchange company. The Customer is responsible for payment of charges to the Company and compliance with all terms and conditions of this tariff.

<u>Disconnect</u> – To render inoperable or to disable circuitry thereby preventing outgoing and incoming telecommunications service.

1.1 <u>Definitions</u> (Cont'd)

<u>Exchange</u> – The geographical area that has been established to administer and furnish communications in that area.

<u>Exchange Service</u> – Service that involves furnishing central office facilities to provide users with the ability to make calls within the local service calling area on a measured or unlimited use bases.

<u>Foreign Exchange Service</u> – Service that involves furnishing central office line facilities to provide users with the ability to make calls within the local calling area on a measured or unlimited use bases.

<u>Incomplete</u> – Any Call where voice transmission between the Calling and Called station is not established.

<u>Interruption</u> – The inability to complete calls due to equipment malfunctions or human errors. Interruptions shall not include, and no allowance shall be given for service difficulties such as slow dialtone, circuits, busy or other network and/or switching capacity shortages. Nor shall interruptions include the failure of service or facilities provided within this Tariff by the Company shall not apply where service is interrupted by the negligence or willful act of the Customer, or where the Company, pursuant to the terms of this Tariff, terminates service because of non-payment of bills, unlawful or improper use of the Company's facilities or service, or any other reason covered by this Tariff or by applicable law.

<u>Holiday</u> – For the purposes of this tariff recognized holidays are New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

<u>LATA</u> – A Local Access and Transport Area established pursuant to the Modification of Final Judgment entered by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in Civil Action No. 82-01102; or any other geographic area designated as a LATA in the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. Tariff F.C.C. No. 4.

<u>Measured Charge</u> – A charge assessed on a per-minute basis in calculating a portion of the charges due for a completed interexchange or local call.

Message – A completed telephone call by a Customer or User.

<u>Message Toll Service</u> – A service involving facilities for telecommunications between local calling service areas.

Non-Business Day – The period of time from 4:01 p.m. to 8:510 a.m., Monday through Friday, and all Saturday and Sunday, as measured by local time at the location from which the Call is originated.

<u>Normal Business Hours</u> – The hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

<u>Premises</u> – The space occupied by an individual Customer in a building, in adjoining buildings occupied entirely by that Customer, or on contiguous property occupied by the Customer separated only by a public thoroughfare, a railroad right of way, or a natural barrier.

<u>Rate</u> – Money, charge, fee or other recurring assessment billed to Customers for services or equipment.

<u>Recurring Charges</u> – The monthly charges to the Customer for services, facilities and equipment, which continue for the agreed upon duration of the service.

<u>Service</u> – The Company's intrastate regulated telecommunications service.

<u>Service Commencement Date</u> – The first day following the date on which the Company notifies the Customer that the requested services or facility is available for use, unless extended by the Customer's refusal to accept service which does not conform to standards set forth in the Service Order or the tariffs of the Company, in which case the Service Commencement date is the date of the Customer's acceptance. The Company and Customer may actually agree on a substitute Service Commencement Date.

<u>Service Order</u> – The written request for network Services executed by the Customer and the Company in the format devised by the Company. The signing of a Service Order by the Customer and acceptance by the Company initiates the respective obligations of the parties as set forth herein and pursuant to the tariffs of the Company, but the duration of the service is calculated from the Service Commencement Date.

<u>Shared</u> – A facility of equipment system that can be used simultaneously by several customers.

<u>State</u> – State of Ohio, unless otherwise noted.

<u>Telecommunications</u> – The transmission of voice communications or subject to the transmission capabilities of the Service, the transmission of data, signaling, metering, or other similar communications.

<u>Terminal Equipment</u> – Telephone instruments, including pay telephone equipment, the common equipment of large and small key and PBX systems and other devices and apparatus, and associated wiring, which are intended to be connected electrically, acoustically, or inductively to the telecommunication system.

<u>User or End User</u> – Customer or any authorized person or entity that utilizes the Company's services.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

2.1 <u>Undertaking of the Company</u>

- 2.1.1 The Company provides facilities-based and resold local exchange telecommunications service to Customers for the direct transmission of voice, data and other types of telecommunications.
- 2.1.2 The Company is responsible for the services provided under this tariff and for unregulated services provided pursuant to contract, and it assumes no responsibility for any service (whether regulated or not) provided by any other Carrier to the End User or to any carrier that purchases access to the Company network.
- 2.1.3 The Company installs, operates and maintains the communications services provided herein in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this tariff. When authorized by the Customer, the Company may act as the Customer's agent for ordering access connection facilities provided by other carriers or entities to allow connection of a Customer's location to the Company's network. The Customer shall be responsible for all charges due for such service arrangements.
- 2.1.4 The Company's services are provided on a monthly basis, unless otherwise stated in this tariff. Services are available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week.
- 2.1.5 The Company's customer service representatives for billing and service inquiries may be reached, toll-free, at 800-772-4667. Customers wishing to communicate with the Company in writing may send correspondence to: 4380 Boulder Highway, Las Vegas, Nevada 89121.

2.2 Limitations of Service

- 2.2.1 Service is offered subject to the availability of facilities and provisions of this tariff.
- 2.2.2 Service is furnished to the User for any lawful purpose. Service shall not be used for any unlawful purpose, nor used in such a manner as to interfere unreasonably with the use of service by any other Users.
- 2.2.3 The use of the Company's services without payment for service or attempting to avoid payment for service by fraudulent means or devices, false or invalid numbers, or false calling or credit cards is prohibited.
- 2.2.4 The Company's services may be denied for nonpayment of charges. Additionally, the Company's services may be denied for noncompliance with any of the Commission's regulations, or for other violations of the terms and conditions set forth in this tariff.
- 2.2.5 The use of the Company's services to make calls which might reasonably be expected to frighten, abuse, torment, or harass another is prohibited.
- 2.2.6 Service temporarily may be refused or limited because of system capacity limitations.
- 2.2.7 Service is subject to transmission limitations caused by natural (including atmospheric, geographic or topographic) or artificial conditions adversely affecting transmission.
- 2.2.8 Service to any or all Customers may be temporarily interrupted or curtailed due to equipment modifications, upgrades, relocations, repairs and similar activities necessary for proper or improved operations.

2.3 <u>Limitations of Liability</u>

- 2.3.1 Because the Company has no control of communications content transmitted over its system, and because of the possibility of errors incident to the provision and use of its service, service furnished by the Company is subject to the terms, conditions and limitations herein specified.
- 2.3.2 The Company is not liable to Users for interruptions in service except as set forth in Section 2.5 of this tariff.
- 2.3.3 The liability of the Company for errors in billing that result in overpayment by the Customer shall be limited, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, to a credit equal to the dollar amount erroneously billed or, in the event that payment has been made and service has been discontinued, to a refund of the amount erroneously billed.
- 2.3.4 The Company shall not be liable for and the User shall indemnify and hold the Company harmless against any claims for loss or damages involving:
 - 2.3.4.A Any act or omission of: (i) the User; or (ii) any other entity furnishing service, equipment or facilities for use in conjunction with services or facilities provided by the Company;
 - 2.3.4.B To the extent permitted under the MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16, interruptions or delays in transmission, or errors or defects in transmission, or failure to transmit when caused by or as a result of acts of God, fire, flood or other catastrophes, war, riots, national emergencies, government or military authorities, strikes, lock-outs, work stoppages or other labor difficulties, or causes beyond the Company's control. Customer credits shall apply to acts and occurrences not exempt from the application of Customer credits for service interruptions under MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16;
 - 2.3.4.C Any unlawful or unauthorized use of the Company's facilities and services;
 - 2.3.4.D Libel, slander or infringement of copyright or trademark arising directly or indirectly from content transmitted over facilities provided by the Company;
 - 2.3.4.E Infringement of patents arising from combining apparatus and systems of the User with facilities provided by the Company;

2.3.4 (Cont'd)

- 2.3.4.F Claims arising out of any act or omission of the User in connection with service provided by the Company;
- 2.3.4.G Breach in the privacy or security of communications transmitted over the Company's facilities;
- 2.3.4.H Changes in any of the facilities, operations or procedures of the Company that:
 (1) render any equipment, facilities or services provided or utilized by the User obsolete; (2) require modification or alteration of such equipment, facilities or services; or (3) otherwise affect use or performance of such equipment, facilities or services except where reasonable notice is required by the Company and is not provided to the Customer;
- 2.3.4.I Defacement of or damage to the Customer's Premises or personal property resulting from the furnishing of services or equipment on such Premises or the installation or removal thereof;
- 2.3.4.J Any wrongful act of a Company employee where such act is not authorized by the Company and is not within the scope of the employee's responsibilities for the Company;
- 2.3.4.K Any non-completed calls due to network busy conditions; and
- 2.3.4.L Any calls not actually attempted to be completed during any period that service is unavailable.

2.3 <u>Limitations of Liability</u> (Cont'd)

- 2.3.5 The User shall reimburse the Company for all costs, expenses and fees, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred by the Company in its defense against claims set forth in Section 2.3.4.
- 2.3.6 The Company assumes no responsibility for the availability or performance of any facilities under the control of other entities that are used to provide service to the User, even if the Company has acted as the User's agent in arranging for such facilities or services.
- 2.3.7 With the exception of billing disputes, any claim against the Company shall be deemed waived unless presented to the Company upon discovery or as soon as possible upon discovery.
- 2.3.8 With respect to the services provided pursuant to this tariff, the Company makes no representations or warranties, express or implied, either in fact or by operation of law, statutory or otherwise, including, but not limited to, warranties of title or implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, except those expressly set forth in this tariff. The Company does not authorize anyone to make a warranty or representation of any kind on its behalf and the User should not rely on any such statement.
- 2.3.9 Any liability of the Company for loss or damages arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors or defects in the service, the transmission of the service, or failures or defects in facilities furnished by the Company, occurring in the course of furnishing service, in no event shall exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate fixed monthly charge assessed on the Customer for the time period in which the service giving rise to the claim occurred.

2.4 <u>Responsibilities of the Customer</u>

- 2.4.1 Customers may be required to enter into a written service order which shall contain or reference a specific description of the service ordered, the rates to be charged, the duration of the services and the terms and conditions in the tariffs of the Company. Customer also may be required to execute any other documents or provide information pertaining to past accounts for similar services as may be reasonably requested by the Company.
- 2.4.2 The Customer is responsible for placing any necessary orders, complying with tariff regulations and assuring that Users comply with tariff regulations. The Customer shall ensure compliance with any applicable laws, regulations, orders or other requirements of any governmental entity relating to services provided by the Company to the Customer or made available by the Customer to another User. The Customer also is responsible for the payment of charges for all Calls originated at the Customer's numbers which are not collect, third party, calling card, or credit card calls.
- 2.4.3 At the expiration of the initial term specified in each Service Order, or any extension thereof, service shall continue on a month to month basis at the then current rates unless terminated by either party. Any termination shall not relieve Customer of its obligation to pay any charges incurred under the service order and the tariffs of the Company prior to termination. The rights and obligations which by their nature extend beyond the termination of the service shall survive such termination.
- 2.4.4 When a Customer cancels an application for service prior to the start of service or prior to any special construction, no charges will be imposed except as follows: where the Company has notified a Customer or prospective Customer of the possibility that special expenses may be incurred in connection with provisioning their services, and then the company does incur such expenses. Expenses could include special construction or where special arrangements of facilities or equipment have begun before the company received a cancellation notice. The charge will be equal to the costs actually incurred, less net salvage.
- 2.4.5 If required for the provisioning of the Company's services, the Customer must provide the Company, free of charge, with any necessary equipment space, supporting structure, conduit and electrical power.
- 2.4.6 The Customer is responsible for arranging access to its Premises at times mutually agreeable to the Company and the Customer when required for Company personnel to install, repair, maintain, program, inspect or remove equipment associated with the provision of the Company's services.

2.4 <u>Responsibilities of the Customer</u> (Cont'd)

- 2.4.7 The Customer must pay the Company for replacement or repair of damage to the Company's equipment or facilities caused by negligent or improper use on the part of the Customer, Users, or others.
- 2.4.8 The Customer must indemnify the Company for the theft of any Company equipment or facilities installed at the Customer's Premises.
- 2.4.9 The Customer agrees to release, indemnify and hold harmless the Company against any and all loss, claims, demands, suits or other action or any liability whatsoever, whether suffered, made, instituted or asserted by the Customer or by any other party or person, for any personal injury to or death of any person or persons, or for any loss of or damage to any property, whether owned by the Customer or others. The Customer shall reimburse the Company for all costs, expenses and fees, including reasonable attorneys' fees, incurred by the Company in its defense against such actions.

2.5 <u>Allowances for Interruptions in Service</u>

2.5.1 General

2.5.1.A Purusant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(A), the Company shall make an adjustment in accordance with MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(B) whenever a subscriber's service is interrupted and remains out of service for more than twenty-four consecutive hours after being reported to the Company or after being found to be out of service.

2.5 <u>Allowances for Interruptions in Service (Cont'd)</u>

2.5.2 Application of Credits for Interrupted Services

- 2.5.2.A As required by MTSS 4901:1-5-16(B), if an out out service condition exceeds twenty-four hours, but is less than forty-eight hours, the Company shall credit the subscriber's bill for at least the pro rata portion of the monthly charge(s) for all regulated local services rendered inoperative during the interruption. Credit for out-of-service conditions lasting longer shall be provided pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(B)(1)-(3).
- 2.5.2.B Credits for failure to install new service in a timely manner shall be applied pursuant to MISS 4901:1-5-16(D).
- 2.5.2.C Credits for missed appointments shall be applied pursuant to MTSS 4901:1-5-16(E).
- 2.5.2.D Credits for failure to incude a subscriber's listing in the white pages of the telephone directory or to correctly list a subscriber's telephone number shall be applied pursuant to MTSS 4901:1-5-16(F).
- 2.5.2.E Adjustments for overcharges or undercharges by the Company shall be made in accordance with MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(G).

2.5.3 Limitations on Allowances

2.5.3.A No credit allowance will be made for any interruption of service resulting from any of the acts or conditions listed in MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-16(A)(1)-(4) and (C).

2.6 <u>Termination of Service</u>

- 2.6.1 A Customer may terminate service, with or without cause, by giving the Company notice, except where cause must be provided pursuant to the Customer's contract or Service Order. If a Customer orders services requiring special equipment and/or facilities dedicated to the Customer's use and then cancels the order before the service begins, a charge will be made to the Customer for the non-recoverable portions of expenditures or liabilities incurred expressly on behalf of the Customer by the Company.
- 2.6.2 Pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(A), local service may only be disconnected for subscriber nonpayment of charges regulated by the Commission.
- 2.6.3 Toll Services may be disconnected for subscriber nonpayment of toll service, subjected to the conditions listed in MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(B).
- 2.6.4 Pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(D), the Company shall notify, or attempt to notify through any reasonable means, a subscriber before service is refused or disconnected when any of the following conditions exist:
 - 2.6.4.A a violation of the Company's tariffs on file with the Commission;
 - 2.6.4.B failure to comply with municipal ordinances or other laws pertaining to telecommunications services; or
 - 2.6.4.C a refusal by the subscriber to permit the local service provider access to its facilities. Pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(F), the Company shall not disconnect the local or toll service of a subscriber who pays the Company the total amount due (or an amount agreed upon between the Company and subscriber) on his/her account by the close of business on the disconnection date listed on the disconnection notice.
- 2.6.5 Service may be disconnected without prior notice for any of the reasons listed under MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(G).

- 2.6.6 Pursuant to MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(K), a subscriber's bill shall not be due earlier than 14 days from the date of the postmark on the bill. If the bill is not paid by the due date, the Company shall not disconnect the service: (a) sooner than 14 days after the bill's due date and (b) without sending a written notice of disconnection, postmarked at least seven (7) days prior to the date of service disconnection. Service may be disconnected only during normal business hours; however, no disconnection for past due bills may be made after 12:30 p.m. on the day preceding a day that all services necessary for reconnection are not available.
- 2.6.7 In compliance with MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-17(M), absent circumstances beyond the Company's control or a request by the subscriber, the Company shall reconnect previously disconnected service by 5 p.m on the next business day following: (a) receipt by the Company of the full amount in arrears for which the service was disconnected, or upon verification by the Company that conditions which warranted disconnection have been eliminated; or (b) agreement by the Company and the subscriber on a deferred payment plan and a payment, if required, under the plan.

2.7 <u>Payment of Charges</u>

- 2.7.1 The Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for service furnished by the Company to the Customer and Users, regardless of whether those services are used by the Customer itself or are resold to or shared with other persons. The Company's invoices and billing practices will comply with MTSS Rule 4901:1-5-15
- 2.7.2 Recurring monthly charges may be invoiced one month in advance. Invoicing cycles are approximately thirty (30) days in length, and payment is due 14 days from bill postmark date. Payment will be considered timely if paid within twenty (20) days of the billing date. After twenty (20) days, payment will be considered late.
- 2.7.3 The Company reserves the right to assess late payment charges for Customers whose account(s) carries principal owing from the prior billing period. Any charges not paid in full by the due date indicated on the billing statement may be subject to a late fee of 1.5% per month.
- 2.7.4 Customers must notify the Company either verbally or in writing of any disputed charges upon discovery and as soon as possible, otherwise all charges on the invoice will be deemed accepted. All charges remain due and payable at the due date, although a Customer is not required to pay any disputed charges during the time period in which the Company conducts its investigation into the matter.
- 2.7.5 In the event of a dispute concerning a bill, Customers must pay a sum equal to the amount of the undisputed portion of the bill and proceed with the complaint procedures set forth in this tariff.

2.8 Deposits

The Company will not require deposits from Customers. Pursuant to MTSS Rule 13, however, prospective customers required to establish creditworthiness may avail themselves of the methods identified in that rule (and by reference in Chapters 4901:1-5 and 4901:1-17 of the Administrative Code), which include submission of a deposit pursuant to subsection 4901:1-5-13(B)(2)(a) ("the individual service history method") representing 230% of the customer's known or estimated monthly charge for local services calculated consistent with that section.

2.9 Advance Payments

The Company will not require advance payments from Customers.

2.10 Contested Charges

All bills are presumed accurate, and shall be binding on the Customer unless objection is received by the Company upon discovery or as soon as possible, either verbally or in writing. In the event that a billing dispute between the Customer and the Company for service furnished to the Customer cannot be settled with mutual satisfaction, the Customer may take the following course of action:

- 2.10.1 First, the Customer may request, and the Company will provide, an in-depth review of the disputed amount. (The undisputed portion and subsequent bills must be paid on a timely basis or the service may be subject to disconnection.)
- 2.10.2 Second, if there is still a disagreement about the disputed amount after investigation and review by the Company, the Customer may file an appropriate complaint with the Ohio Public Utilities Commission. The address of the Commission is:

2.11 <u>Transfers and Assignments</u>

Neither the Company nor the Customer may assign or transfer its rights or duties in connection with the Services and facilities provided by the Company without the written consent of the other party, except that the Company may assign its rights and duties (a) to any subsidiary, parent company or affiliate of the Company, (b) pursuant to any sale or transfer of substantially all the assets of the Company, or (c) pursuant to any financing, merger or reorganization of the Company.

2.12 <u>Temporary Promotional Programs</u>

The Company may establish temporary promotional programs under which it may waive or reduce non-recurring or recurring charges, to introduce present or potential Customers to a Service not previously received by the Customers. The specific terms of each promotional program shall be filed with the Commission within 30 days of its effective date.

2.13 Application of Rates

2.13.1 Introduction

The regulations set forth in this Section govern the application of rates for services contained in Section 4 and 5 of the tariffs of the Company.

2.13.2 Rates Based on Duration of Use

Where charges for a service are specified based on the duration of use, such as the duration of a telephone call, the following rules apply:

- a. Unless otherwise specified, calls are timed in one minute increments. All calls which are fractions of a measurement increment are rounded-up to the next whole unit.
- b. Timing on completed calls begins when the call is answered by the called party. Answering is determined by hardware answer supervision in all cases where this signaling is provided by the terminating local carrier and any intermediate carrier(s).

c. Timing terminates on all calls when the calling party hangs up or the Company's network receives an on-hook signal from the terminating carrier.

2.13.3 Rates Based Upon Distance

Where charges for a service are specified based upon distance, the following rules apply:

- a. Distance between two points is measured as airline distance between the Rate Centers of the originating and terminating telephone lines. The Rate Center is a set of geographic coordinates, as referenced in National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. Tariff FCC No. 4, associated with each NPA-NXX combination (where NPA is the area code and NXX is the first three digits of a seven-digit telephone number). Where there is no telephone number associated with an access line on the Company's network (such as a dedicated access line), the Company will apply the Rate Center of the Customer's main billing telephone number.
- b. The airline distance between any two Rate Centers is determined as follows:
 - 1) Obtain the "V" (vertical) and "H" (horizontal) coordinates for each Rate Center from the above-referenced NECA tariff.
 - 2) Compute the difference between the "V" coordinates of the two rate centers; and the difference between the two "H" coordinates.
 - 3) Square each difference obtained in step (2) above.
 - 4) Add the square of the "V" difference and the square of the difference obtained in step (3) above.
 - 5) Divide the sum of the squares by 10. Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction is obtained.

2.13.4 Flexible Pricing

2.13.4.A General

Flexible Pricing sets maximum rates that can be charged for telephone service. The Company may change a specific rate within the range of the established maximum rates on one day's notice to customers and the Public Utilities Commission .

2.13.4.B Conditions

- 2.13.4.B.1 The Company reserves the right to change prices at any time subject to regulatory requirements by filing a revised Rate Attachment with the Commission.
- 2.13.4.B.2 Individual written notice to Customers of rate changes shall be made in accordance with Commission regulations. Where there are no regulations, notification will be made in a manner appropriate to the circumstances involved.
- 2.13.4.B.3 A rate shall not be changed unless it has been in effect for at least thirty (30) days.
- 2.13.4.B.4 A Customer can request that the Company disconnect service that is provided under the Flexible Pricing due to a price increase. The Customer will be credited for the difference for the new price and the old price retroactive to the effective date of the price increase if the Customer notifies the Company of its desire to disconnect service within 20 days of receiving notification of the price increase.

2.14 Timing of Calls

- 2.14.1 The Customer's monthly usage charges for the Company service are based upon the total number of minutes the Customer uses and the service options to which the Customer subscribes. Chargeable time begins at the time the called party answers (i.e. when two-way communications is possible), and ends when either party hangs up.
- 2.14.2 No charges apply if a Call is not completed.
- 2.14.3 For billing purposes, all Calls are rounded up to the nearest minute and billed in increments of one minute. The minimum Call duration is one (1) minute for a connected Call.
- 2.14.4 Where applicable, charges will be rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 2.14.5 Usage begins when the called party picks up the receiver (i.e. when two-way communication is possible). A Call is terminated when the calling or called party hangs up. The Company utilizes software answer supervision, which permits up to sixty (60) seconds of ringing before the Call becomes billed usage. Where answer supervision is not available, any Call for which the duration exceeds sixty (60) seconds shall be presumed to have been answered and becomes billed usage.
- 2.14.6 The Company will not knowingly charge for Incomplete or unanswered Calls. Upon the Customer's request and proper verification, the Company shall promptly adjust or credit the Customer's account for charges or payments for any Incomplete or unanswered Call inadvertently billed due to the unavailability of Feature Group D or due to another carrier's failure to provide answer supervision. Upon the Customer's request and proper verification, the Company also shall promptly adjust or credit the Customer's account for charges or payments for Calls placed to a wrong number.

3.2 <u>Local Exchange Services</u>

3.2.1 Standard Access Line

The Standard Residential or Business Line provides a Customer with a single, analog, voice-grade telephonic communications channel which can be used to place or receive one call at a time. Standard Lines are provided for the connection of Customer-provided wiring and single station sets or facsimile machines. A multi-line subscriber is a Business customer with more than one Line provided by Company. Standard Access Lines enable the customer to:

- (a) place or receive calls to any station in the local calling area, as defined herein;
- (b) access enhanced 911 Emergency Service where available;
- (c) access the interexchange carrier selected by the Customer for interLATA, intraLATA, interstate or international calling;
- (d) access Operator Services;
- (e) access Directory Assistance;
- (f) place or receive calls to 800 numbers;
- (g) access Telecommunications Relay Service.

The Company's service will automatically block originating calls to other telephone companies' caller-paid information services (e.g., 900, 976) at no charge. Calls to those numbers and other numbers used for caller-paid information services will be unblocked on a per directory number basis only. Subsequent blocking of 900-type numbers will incur a charge listed in Section 4.

3.2.1.A Off Premise Extension

Extension service is an extension of lines at locations in addition to the location of the main line. Extension service is connected to an individual, auxiliary two party or four party line for the same subscriber and with the same telephone number.

Service may be provided in conjunction with other services and products included in this Section.

3.2.2.B Local Business Line Service

Local Business Line Service provides a Business Customer with the ability to originate calls from Company-provided access lines to all other stations on the public switched telephone network bearing the designation of any central office exchanges, areas, and zones included in the Customer's local calling area. Service may be provided in conjunction with other services and products included in this Section.

3.2.2.C Extended and Expanded Area Calling Services

Extended and Expanded Area Calling Service allows the Customer to make calls to specific NXX codes within designated exchanges outside the Customer's Local Calling area without paying intraLATA toll rates. The Customer is billed per call according to the duration of the call. Company will mirror all existing extended and expanded calling areas the ILEC currently has in place for facilities-based or resold services.

3.2.3.A NOS Major Deal Plan

NOS Major Deal Plan is a package of value added services combined into one product offered at a reduced monthly rate to Residential end users.

3.2.3.B NOS Local Calling Plan

NOS Local Calling Plan is an optional intrastate intraLATA one-way offering to certain exchanges within Ohio. The calling area for each LCP exchange includes the home exchange, Local Calling Area exchanges and other designated exchanges. The regulations and rates contained herein are in addition to all other applicable regulations and rates specified in this and other Company tariffs. Certain other services and calling plans may not be available to customers that opt to use this service.

NOS Local Calling Plan consists of the following options:

Community Call: provides flat rate calling within the customer's home exchange and Local Calling Area exchanges listed in GTE North Inc. Tariff P.U.C.O. No. 6, Section 3. Calls to certain other exchanges are rate based on minutes of use.

Community Extra: provides flat rate calling within the customer's home exchange as well as to the Local Calling Area exchanges listed in GTE North Inc. Tariff P.U.C.O. No. 6, Section 3 and to certainother exchanges. Calls to certain other exchanges are rate based on minutes of use.

Premier Calling: provides flat rate calling within the customer's home exchange, Local Calling Area exchanges and other designated exchanges.

NOS Local Calling will not be offered to following classes of service: Customer-Owned Pay Telephone Service, Customer Owned Coin Operated Telephone Service, Foreign Exchange Service, Telephone Service Assistance, WATS or Feature Group A.

3.3 <u>Miscellaneous Local Features</u>

3.3.1 Busy Line Verification and Interrupt Service

Busy Line Verification and Interrupt Service, furnished to the extent facilities permit, provides the customer with the following options:

- 3.3.1.A Busy Line Verification: Upon request of the calling party, the Company will determine if the line is clear or in use and report to the calling party.
- 3.3.1.B Busy Line Verification and Interrupt: The operator will interrupt the call on the called line only if the calling party indicates and emergency and requests interruption.

3.3.2 Call Blocking Features

A calling party may block their telephone number, associated main listed name and voiceback of calling identification information to users or subscribers to customer calling features utilizing SS7 technology. Blocking will also prevent call completion through the use of Return Call service. Customers have three blocking options: (1) Per Call Blocking, (2) Per Line Blocking, or (3) Class Call Blocking. These features allow the end-user to automatically block incoming calls from up to six Customer pre-selected telephone numbers (including numbers from which a Customer has just received a call. The list of numbers can be changed at any time. Callers whose numbers have been blocked will hear a recorded message and no usage charges will apply. The calling party's number will not be delivered or announced to the call recipient under any circumstances.

3.3.3 <u>Calling Card Services</u>

The Company's Calling Card Services are offered to Customers of its local exchange and long distance services. The Company's Calling Card Services are accessed by dialing a toll-free number and entering the Calling Card Number (area code, phone number, and PIN).

3.3.4 Touch Dial Calling Service

Touch dial calling service provides for the origination of telephone calls through the use of pushbuttons transmitting alternating currents in lieu of rotary dial or push buttons transmitting direct current. The service is furnished for use with individual and two-party central office lines, and with residential exchange service lines. It may be furnished to either one or both subscribers on a two party line. Touch dial calling service requires special central office equipment and will be provided only from central offices where facilities are available.

3.3.5 Directory Assistance

Provides for identification of telephone directory numbers, via an operator or automated platform. Customers are provided with a maximum of 2 listings per each call to Directory Assistance.

3.3.6 <u>Directory Assistance Call Completion</u>

Directory Assistance Call Completion Service provides the Customer with the ability to use a directory assistance operator to provide listing information and to automatically dial the number requested.

3.3.7 <u>Directory Listings</u>

For each Customer of Company-provided Exchange Service(s), the Company shall arrange for the listing of the Customer's main billing telephone number in the directory(ies) published by the dominant Local Exchange Carrier in the area at no additional charge. Directory listings are provided in connection with each Customer service as specified herein. The Company reserves the right to limit the length of any listing in the directory by the use of abbreviations when, in its judgment, the clearness of the listing or the identification of the Customer is not impaired thereby. When more than one line is required to properly list the Customer, no additional charge is made. The following types of listings will be made available: (1) primary; (2) additional; (3) non-published; (4) non-listed; (5) alternate call; and (6) reference.

3.3.8 <u>Local Number Portability</u>

Local Number Portability End User charge is a pass-through charge assessed to recover the authorized FCC charges incurred by the Company from the incumbent local exchange carrier ("ILEC") related to the provision of long-term number portability. The Local Number Portability End User charge is assessed per the local exchange service line and will be passed through to the customer during the authorized recovery period, which will not exceed the authorized recovery period of the ILEC.

3.4 <u>Custom Calling Features</u>

- 3.4.1 <u>Automatic Call Return/*69</u>: Enables a Customer to automatically return the last incoming Call. To return the call, the Customer dials a feature Code and the number is dialed automatically. If the called line is busy, a 30-minute queuing process begins. The Customer is then given an indication that the network will attempt to set up the Call when the called line is idle.
- 3.4.2 <u>Busy Number Re-dial</u>: This feature automatically redials another party's phone number after the Customer's first attempt to connect to that number resulted in a busy signal. The line is checked every 45 seconds for up to 30 minutes and alerts the Customer with a distinctive ringing pattern when the busy number and the Customer's line are free. The Customer can continue to make and receive other calls while the feature is activated.

3.5 <u>Maintenance and Installation Charges</u>

3.5.1 <u>Maintenance Visit Charges</u>

Maintenance Visit Charges apply when the Company dispatches personnel to a Customer's premises to perform work necessary for resolving troubles reported by the Customer and the trouble is found to be caused by the Customer's facilities. The time period for which the Maintenance Visit Charges is applied will commence when Company personnel are dispatched at the Customer premises and end when work is completed. The rates for Maintenance of Service vary by time per Customer request. Prior to visiting a customer premise, where applicable, the Company shall first inform Customers who call with service problems of the network interface device ("NID"), as well as inform these Customers of how to use the NID to isolate trouble to the inside or outside line. If there is no NID at the customer's premises or it is inaccessible to the customer, no maintenance charges shall apply for Company personnel to visit the Customer's premises for purposes of conducting diagnostics to determine the location of the problem. Should the problem be identified as caused by the Customer's facilities, however, charges shall apply for all work subsequently conducted in the Customer's premises.

3.5.2 <u>Service/Installation Ordering Charge</u>

This charge applies to receiving, recording and processing Customer requests for work to be done in connection with the same service at the same time at one or more locations of that service. It has three possible applications: (1) connection new or additional exchange access lines; (2) move or change existing service and equipment or add new or additional service and equipment other than exchange access; (3) record type only change.

3.5.3 Non-Routine Installation

At the Customer's request, installation and/or maintenance may be performed outside the Company's regular business hours or in unusual locations. In such cases, charges based on cost of the actual labor, material, or other costs incurred by or charged to the Company will apply. If installation is started during regular business hours but, at the Customer's request, extends beyond regular business hours into time periods including, but not limited to weekends, holidays, and/or night hours, additional charges may apply.

3.5.4 Central Office Exchange Access Line Charge

This covers work associated with the line extending from the serving central office up to and including the Rate demarcation Point on the customer's premises. Major work functions are central office cross-connect work, work done with distribution facilities outside of the central office, and connection of drop wire to the protector at the Customer's premises.

3.5.5 <u>Element Service Charges</u>

Element Service Charges for work activities performed in connection with Channel Service are charged for at business rates except for orders for residence foreign central office district and foreign exchange services.

3.6 <u>Miscellaneous Services Charges</u>

3.6.1 Reconnection

Reconnection charges occur where service to an existing Customer has been disconnected for proper cause, and the Customer desires to resume service with the Company. If service has been discontinued for proper cause and where a Customer desires reconnection, the Customer will be charged a fee to defray the cost of providing service.

3.6.2 Missed Appointment Charge

When the Company and the Customer have agreed to an installation date and time, and the Customer is not available at the premises to allow for installation of service at the appointed time, a Missed Appointment Charge will apply. Customers may not cancel or change installation dates or times on less than 48 hours notice to the Company unless otherwise agreed to by the Company. The Missed Appointment Charge shall not apply where the trouble is isolated to the outside.

3.6.3 <u>Bad Check Charge</u>

If payment for Service is made by a check, draft, or similar instrument (collectively "Check") that is returned to the Company unpaid by a bank or other financial institution for any reason, the Company may bill the Customer a returned check charge. In addition, the Customer may be required to replace the returned Check with a payment in cash or equivalent to cash, such as cashier's check, certified check or money order.

3.6.4 <u>Late Payment Fee</u>

A late payment fee of 1.5% will be applied to service charges not paid by the due date of the bill. The late payment fee will not be applied to previous late payment charges that have been assessed but remain unpaid, but will apply to the accumulated amount for which the Customer is in arrears.

3.7 Promotional Service Offerings

From time to time, the Company may offer services or waive or vary service rates for promotional, market research or other similar business purposes.

The Wheeling Area Exchange Area consists of three zones located in Ohio, and four zones located in West Virginia and operated by the Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Compnay of West Virginia, as follows:

b. Messages Between Zones

All messages from stations of each of the Ohio zones to other stations of the Wheeling Area Exchange Area are considered to be local messages.

c. Foreign Zone Service

- 1) Where exchange service is furnished to a customer located in a zone within Ohio through a central office of a zone within Ohio other than that regularly serving the zone in which the customer is located, the regulations, rates and charges for foreign central office service are applicable.
- 2) Where exchange service is furnished to a customer in an Ohio zone through a central office in a West Virginia zone or to a customer in a West Virginia zone through a central office in an Ohio zone, the portion of the facilities in Ohio are furnished as covered in 3-a above. For the portion of the facilities located in West Virginia, charges apply as specified in the intrastate tariff of The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company of West Virginia.

d. All other circuits and Channels

- 1) Where the terminals of the circuit or channel are located in Ohio and in the same or in different zones, circuit rates apply as specified for cicuits or channels "within the same exchange area".
- Where the terminals of the circuit or channel are located in a zone in Ohio and in a zone in West Virginia, the provisions of 4-a above apply to the portion of the facilities in Ohio for the portion of the facilities in West Virginia, charges apply as specified in the intrastate tariff of The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company of West Virginia.
- e. In the application of rates and charges for other items of service included in this tariff or the Private Line Service Tariff and with respect to the application of message toll telephone servie rates, or any other matter covered by any other telephone Company tariff, the terms "zone" and "zone area" as used in this paragraph have the same meaning as the terms "exchange" and "exchange area".

8.1 <u>General Description</u>

Company either shall require customer confirmation of the competitive offer in writing or shall confirm the availability of a more favorable competitive rate from published tariffs, marketing materials, or other public sources to establish a customer's right to obtain a Promotional, Special Service and/or Telecompetitive Service offering.

8.2 Customer Loyalty Plan

Customers who qualify as either a "save" or a "winback" and who meet the eligibility requirements set forth herein will receive a credit on either their 4, 6th or 9th invoice as selected by Customer upon service initiation and as provided following.

- 8.2.1 For each three, five or eight invoices (for credit months 4, 6 and 9, respectively) of consecutive uninterrupted service, a credit shall be calculated equal to the lower of either (i) the average of the Customer's monthly charges excluding fees, taxes, surcharges, assessments, and similar charges ("eligible charges"), for the preceding consecutive eight-month period; or (ii) a credit which equals the eligible charges on the invoice in which the credit is applied.
- 8.2.2 To be eligible for the 4th, 6th or 9th invoice free bonus, each Customer must:
 - 8.2.2.A have initiated service;
 - 8.2.2.B have no record of nonpayment in any of the preceding consecutive twelvemonth period of service;
 - 8.2.2.C have received eight consecutive and uninterrupted invoices over the preceding eight-month period;
 - 8.2.2.D have selected the 9th invoice free bonus incentive prior to the first day in the period of service covered by Customer's ninth invoice; and
 - 8.2.2.E pay all charges rendered in Customer's ninth invoice in excess of the amount of the applicable credit as calculated preceding.
- 8.2.3 Beginning July 15, 2006, customers receiving a credit under the "Every Fourth Invoice Free" Customer Loyalty Plan, will have the "Every Fourth Invoice Free" |
 Customer Loyalty Plan removed from their accounts, and will have the "Every Ninth Invoice Free" Customer Loyalty Plan added to their accounts in substitution. For purposes of calculating when a customer will receive a credit under the newly substituted "Every Ninth Invoice Free" Customer Loyalty Plan, the Company will begin the calculation with the customer's first invoice following the last credit invoice under the "Every Fourth Invoice Free" |
 Customer Loyalty Plan.
